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Certification – NEEDS UPDATING

- Promotion of CVA International certification program
- Total CVA's in Canada = 106;
 There is a 32% increase over last year
- 15 applications already received for the Fall
 2016 testing window
- 30% of the Spring 2016 test takers were Canadian




Certification – NEEDS UPDATING




